



COVID-19 Precautions

The health and safety of our patients and their families and the staff is our top priority. Park Pediatric Dentistry has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 health situation during this time and with the recent news that Governor Kemp's statewide Shelter-in-Place order has been lifted, Park Pediatric Dentistry will be reopening the office for routine dental visits with a limited schedule. The office has implemented new safety precautions that you will see when it is time for your next appointment. The practice is closely following the guidelines of the World Health Organization, Centers for Disease Control, the American Dental Association and the Georgia Dental Association.

To ensure the safety of our patients and our team, the practice is taking the following measures:

- Our office follows strict cleaning protocols and has increased the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting throughout the day between each patient.
- All staff follow recommended handwashing/sanitizing before and after all patient interactions.
- Our clinical staff will continue to wear OSHA compliant personal protective equipment in accordance with the American Dental Association.
- Appointments will be managed to allow for social distancing between patients. That might mean we will only be able to offer limited scheduling options at this time.
- Patients are asked to call upon arrival and wait in their vehicles until the office is ready for you.
- Families will be asked to wear face coverings and use hand sanitizer when entering the office.
- The number of people in the office and waiting areas will be at a minimum at all times.
- Out of respect for the health of all patients and staff, all patients will be screened when making an appointment and at check in.
- A temporal thermometer will be used on all patients, families and staff upon entering the office.
- Any patients or caregivers who are sick or present with any cold or flu symptoms will be asked to reschedule to a later date.

Our goal is to keep all our patients healthy and safe as we continue to provide the excellent dental care that you have come to expect from us. As we continue to monitor this situation, our office will update you on any changes to our office schedule. Remember that handwashing and staying home if you are sick is the best precaution.
